- poster presentations should be presented on the ISO216 sheet: width -0.841 m, height - 1.189 m. The authors of the poster presentations must be present according to the program for question sessions.

THE PROCEDURE OF PARTICIPATION IN THE CONGRESS:

ATTENTION: The Congress will be held in a mixed mode (offline/online) using modern information technologies, *online participation is free (an electronic certificate of the Congress participant will be sent to online participants)*

For online and remote participation in the Congress, you must *register on the official website of the Congress and pay the publication fee (payment for publication is made only after confirmation by the scientific committee that your materials are applied for publication).*

To participate in the Congress in person, you must **register on the official website of the Congress**, pay the publication fee, and **also pay the registration fee.**

The publication fee and registration fee are paid by bank wire transfer to the account of the IPO "Sport, People and Health" (**details of the organisation** are on the website and in Appendix No. 3).



REGISTRATION FEE

**The cost of publishing an article for the staff – organisers and co-organisers of the Congress - 12 €*

A **printed and electronic** Collection of Materials of the Congress will be published with the full text of scientific articles of the Congress participants. The collection will be posted in the RSCI.

*In case of **full-time** participation in the Congress of several co-authors of the report, each of them must register on the website.*

REQUIREMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE DESIGN OF SCIENTIFIC ARTICLES ACCEPTED FOR PUBLICATION IN THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE CONGRESS.

THE END OF THE RECEPTION OF SCIENTIFIC MATERIALS IS **FEBRUARY 01, 2025**.

- For **UNREGISTERED** participants: it is necessary to pass **REGISTRATION** on the Congress website, log in to your **PERSONAL ACCOUNT**, using the username and password you received during registration, and click on "*Download the scientific report article*".
- Articles that have scientific novelty, relevance, and practical significance, and are formatted according to these requirements, will be considered for publication.
- The content of the articles should correspond to the **scope of the Congress**.
- Articles containing signs of falsification of research results, original data, and information, as well as plagiarism - presenting someone else's ideas and achievements as their own, and using other people's texts without citing the source - will not be published.
- Materials must be designed in accordance with the requirements and submitted in Russian or English (translations made by means of an automatic online translator without appropriate editing are not accepted).
- The volume of the article is **up to 6 full A4 pages**, including the list of literature, tables and figures, the orientation of the sheet is "vertical".
- Text editor: **Microsoft Word** for Windows version 6.0 and higher.
- Page margins: top, bottom, right - 2.0 cm, left 3.0 cm.
- Font type: Times New Roman, font size – 14 pt.
- Line spacing – **one and a half**, width alignment. Without text wrapping.
- Paragraph indentation, the same throughout the text - 1.0 cm.



- When sending the article for the review, it is necessary to point out the UDC of the article in accordance with the tables found via link: <https://teacode.com/online/udc/>

The Scientific Committee reserves the right to reject articles that do not correspond to the thematic areas of the Congress, or the design requirements, or received by the Scientific committee later than **FEBRUARY 01, 2025**, as well as to the final editing of articles when they are published.

Notification of the authors on the status of the publication of the article in the Collection by **MARCH 01, 2025**, on the inclusion in the program of oral or poster reports of the Congress - no later than **MARCH 31, 2025**.

By **March 20, 2025, each participant must confirm their presentation with a report (form of participation).*

RECOMMENDED ARTICLE CONSTRUCTION SCHEME:

1. Number and name of the Congress section.
2. UDC.
3. The title of the article in Russian and English: font 14, Times New Roman, capital letters, bold, formatting - in the center of the page.
4. The authors' surnames and initials, title, academic degree in Russian and English: under the title, font 14, Times New Roman, formatting — in the center of the page.
5. Abbreviated official name of the organization in Russian and English: under the surnames and initials of the authors, font 14, Times New Roman, formatting — in the center of the page.
6. City and country in Russian and English (specify for each author): under the name of the organization, font 14, Times New Roman, formatting — in the center of the page.
7. A brief **summary** of the article in Russian and English (up to 500 characters with spaces), which should include the following aspects: subject, topic, purpose of the work, method and methodology of conducting the work, results of the work, application area of the results, conclusions.
8. Keywords (in Russian/English languages) are selected from the text of the material (at least 3 and no more than 10) and placed on a separate line after the abstract. The keywords are given in the nominative case.



9. Entries 3-8 are to be written in English and Russian languages separately. Names of the authors must be transliterated.
10. A brief introduction (where existing results in this field of study and the objectives of the work aimed at achieving new knowledge need to be presented).
11. Research methods (materials and methods).
12. Research results and their analysis.
13. Conclusion (conclusions).
14. The number of co-authors in one article is allowed no more than 4.
15. All bibliographic sources presented in the publication should be referenced in the text of the article: registration according to GOST 7.0.5-2008.
16. The bibliographic list in alphabetical order is placed at the end of the article: registration according to GOST R 7.0.100-2018.

*Footnotes in the text of the article are placed in square brackets directly in the text or at the end of the sentence, indicating first the number of the source according to the list of references, then, separated by a comma, the page number, the dot at the end of the sentence is placed after square brackets, for example [1, p. 21].

Note:

- a) **drawings (graphs, charts)** in Word. Excel editors, placed in the text, must be **black and white and presented as separate files.**
- b) each article is designed as a separate file

ILLUSTRATIVE MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR SCIENTIFIC ARTICLES

1. Figures, diagrams and formulae should allow editing. Diagrams and charts drawn in Excel should be submitted to the publishing house in Excel.
2. Graphic images obtained using specialised application programs should be saved in vector form and exported in eps format. When saving in raster form, it is required to provide high image resolution (at least 300 dpi).



3. Mathematical expressions should be made in MathType formula editors or in-built in MS Word.
4. Photographs should be submitted electronically in .tif or .jpeg format. The resolution should not be less than 300 dpi. It is not allowed to deform - stretch or compress - the image, it is obligatory to keep the proportions of the original.
5. Captions on the illustrative materials must be in the language of the publication. Captions are obligatory. The text of the caption is placed under the figure or diagram, for example: Figure 1. Title.
6. The title of the table is written above the table, for example: Table 1. Title. Tables should not be scanned, but created in MS Word or MS Excel.
7. The source of the data and illustrative material must be indicated. Example: Compiled from: [Ivanov, 2002] or Source: [Ivanov, 2002, p.5-6]. The author's materials used in the article do not need to be cited.
8. If the photo (picture) is taken from an open photobank that allows free downloading of content, it is necessary to specify: the name of the photobank and site, link to the resource, name/pseudonym of the author of the photo, year of creation or publication of the photo (picture).
